#### The Courts Committee News

The committee formerly known as The Tennis Committee has voted to change its name to The Courts Committee.

#### New Court Surface

The growing number of cracks, "dead spots" and bird baths through the last few seasons of play necessitated court repair. The Courts Committee spent the fall of 2022 consulting with local companies on how to proceed. We received various feedback, the most extreme of which was that we needed a complete overhaul of the courts. We opted for a moderate recommendation for thorough court resurfacing through New England Sealcoating. Repair work, including leveling, removing vegetation, and resurfacing is scheduled to be complete by June 23. We are very excited for a fresh surface!

#### Pickle Ball Updates

Pickleball continues to see growth and interest. Court time will be set aside for Pickleball on Wednesday (9-11), Friday (9-11) and Sunday (9:30-11:30). All levels are welcome and some extra paddles and balls are available. No sign-ups, just drop in!

In order to address noise concerns from neighbors, the Courts Committee is making the following recommendations and changes:

- We request that pickleball play is limited to the hours of 9am-6pm
- We will be purchasing new, quieter balls to be available with the other pickleball equipment
- We will be purchasing two roll out nets to cut down on noise of net assembly and to improve efficiency of pickleball play

#### 2023 Tennis/Courts Memberships

This is IN ADDITION TO a paid Active or Associate memberships. It allows a member to reserve and use any DIIA courts for racquet sports and participate in any DIIA racquet activities. Both membership dues and Tennis/Courts membership must be paid prior to reserving courts or participating in events.

#### 1. Family Tennis

- This is IN ADDITION TO a paid Family Active or Associate membership
- It allows any member of a family to reserve and use any DIIA courts for racquet sports and participate in any DIIA Racquet activities

#### 2. Adult Tennis

- This is IN ADDITION TO a paid Active or Associate membership

#### 2023 Little Kids Day Camp

The fees for day camp are separate from Membership dues and are not paid online. Little Kid Day Camp is for children ages 4-7. The day camp meets at the Community House Monday-Friday from 9 to 11:30am. Payment is due when enrolling your child in the day camp for that week or day. There is a \$15 "drop-in" fee per child per day. Note: *The fees listed for 2nd and 3rd child only apply only to children of the same family*.

#### **Community House Rules**

Our Community House is located in a residential neighborhood. Wishing to be good neighbors, we ask that you adhere to the following rules:

- The key and permission to use the Community House may be obtained only from the Executive Director, President or Vice President.
- No alcoholic beverages are permitted on DIIA property.
- Music and noise level must be kept down and be respectful of other residents.
- Please NO climbing on the Community House roof or fences.
- There are two (2) playgrounds: the playground located behind the community house is designed and reserved for small children (up to 7 years old). All children older than 7 years old, please use the other playground on the opposite side of the tennis courts. Please remember to respect the rules and the equipment.
- Please respect the Memorial Flag Pole.

In addition, here are some other notices:

- A permit is required for any outdoor fire permits can be obtained from the Town of Wells Fire Department.
- No alcohol is allowed on the beach or on any public property.
- The use of consumer fireworks is prohibited anywhere within the Town of Wells.
- Dogs must be leashed please see the town ordinance section.
- The maximum speed limit of Drakes Island is 25 mph or less and modified depending on conditions. Please respect walkers, runners, children play areas, and need to keep down dust on dirt roads.

We hope that these rules will help maintain good conduct, encourage respect for our neighbors, and preserve our property. Parents, please inform your children of these rules.

#### **Town of Wells Ordinances**

#### Dogs in the Beach Area (§ 86-1)

Between April 1 through June 15, dogs are not permitted within the beach area unless on a leash and under charge of a responsible person. From June 16 through September 15, dogs are not permitted within the beach areas between the hours of 8:00 AM and 6:00 PM. From 6:00 PM until 8:00 AM, dogs are permitted within the beach area only when on a leash and under charge of a responsible person. Exceptions: This section does not apply to dogs on the property of their owner or another property with the owner's permission, to Seeing Eye dogs assisting an individual with a disability, or to working police dogs.

#### Clean Up of Pet Waste (§ 80-5)

It is a violation for any person who owns, possesses or controls a dog or any other animal to fail to remove and dispose of any feces left by his/her animal, except on the property belonging to the animal's owner or keeper. Disposal shall be accomplished by transporting such feces to an appropriate waste receptacle.

#### Use of Fireworks (§ 115-4)

The use of consumer fireworks is prohibited anywhere within the Town of Wells. Use of consumer fireworks in violation of this chapter shall be subject to a fine plus attorney's fees and costs for each offense.

#### **DIIA Court Rules**

Court Hours:Tennis: 8 am - 8 pm / Pickleball: 9 am - 6 pmBackboard Hours:9 am - 8 pm

- Tennis courts are to be used only for tennis, pickleball or other pre-approved activities.
- Tennis shoes (non-marking soles) are required.
- Players are expected to leave the courts neat and tidy.
- Parents are responsible for their children adhering to the tennis rules.

#### **Reserved Court Time**

Membership dues and the individual tennis assessments are required to be paid in advance prior to reserving court time.

#### **Sign-up Procedures**

- A sign-up sheet for the following day's play will be posted at 9 am on the bulletin board.
- Sign-up sheets will be posted for fall and spring weekends as needed.
- DIIA organized events and tennis lessons are given priority over all other court use.
- Reserved court time is restricted to 1 hour per individual membership/per day.
- Tournament and Round Robin players may not reserve a court on the day of their event.

#### Weekend and Holiday Play

- Children ("Under 16" membership) may play with adults at any time, but may not sign up for adults, or themselves, on weekends or holidays.
- Reserved court time is restricted to 2 hours per family per day on weekends and holidays.

#### Cancellations

- Reservations must be canceled at least 30 minutes prior to reservation time.
- A court is forfeited if not claimed within 10 minutes of start time.
- Repeated "No Shows" will be reported to the Tennis Committee and restricted court time may result.

#### Any member may use an unclaimed or open court, with preference to adults on the weekends

All players are asked to observe appropriate court etiquette, and to respect the rights of other players. Please direct any questions or concerns to a member of the Tennis Committee.




