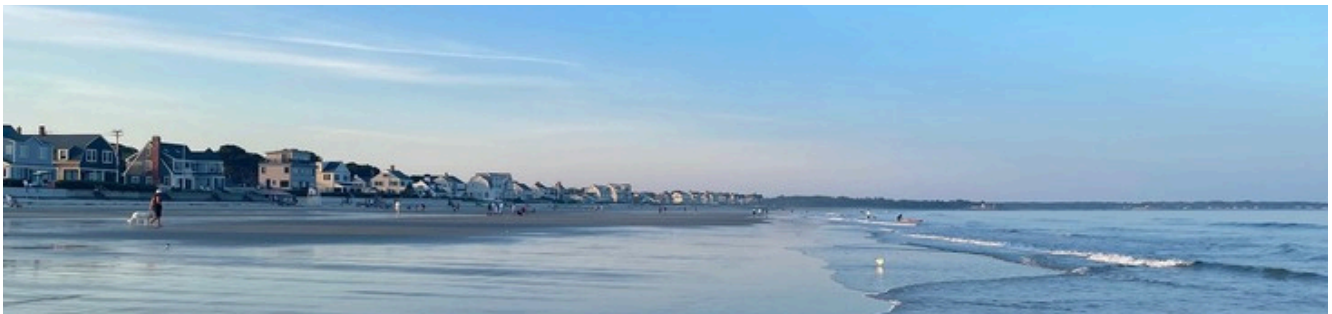

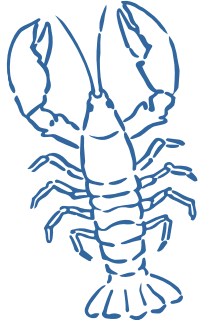

# Letter from the DIIA President

Dear DIIA Community,

This season, necessary crack repair work will be completed on the courts to ensure they are safe and playable for the summer. As always, we ask that everyone respect the posted court hours and rules for both tennis and pickleball, which are in effect year-round. Owners are kindly asked to communicate these rules and hours to their guests and renters.

We are excited to welcome back Molly Cullen as Executive Director, continuing to oversee both the camp and tennis programs. Our camp leadership team includes Big Kids Camp Director Grey DeNatale and Assistant Director Kelsey Ackerman, along with Little Kids Camp Director Cassidy Hall and Assistant Director Rebecca Donovan. We are grateful to have a strong group of counselors to help make this summer a memorable one for campers. On the courts, we welcome back Tennis Director Tanner Wendle, along with instructors Bailey Burke, Ian Pentland, Ryan Cullen and Henry Maneikis.

Our 2026 apparel sales are a highlight to look forward to this summer. Building on the success of last year's offerings, the crew will be bringing back many favorite items along with some fun new additions. They now accept credit cards and Apple Pay! ## Driftwood

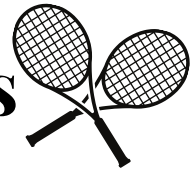

## Court Fees

Any adult or child who uses the courts for tennis or pickleball in any way must have a paid DIIA PLUS COURTS membership. Court usage includes formal and informal tennis or pickleball play, Ladies or Men's tennis tally, the DIIA adult tennis tournament, pickleball round robin or individual drop-in play or otherwise. You must have a current DIIA membership in order to purchase a Court membership. A Court membership is an add-on to a DIIA membership. ## Pickleball Updates

### Organized Play

Like past seasons, court time will be set aside for organized pickleball play on Wednesday (9-11am), Friday (9-11am) and Sunday (9:30-11:30am). All levels are welcome. No sign-up needed, just show up! Plastic balls are allowed during organized play.

### Drop-In Play

For information on pickleball hours for "drop-in play," please see hours posted at the courts. Plastic balls are allowed during these hours only. Please respect the posted hours. These times are in effect year-round, and should be followed during the high and off seasons. Pickleball with plastic balls is NOT allowed on Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Saturdays.



## Use of Quiet Balls

If you use Gamma Librarian quiet balls while playing pickleball at Drakes Island, you may sign up for any open court, any day, from 8am-8pm. Quiet balls are available for any Courts member's use, and are in the tennis storage container on the back deck of the Community House. Please use them! They really work well and have virtually no sound impact whatsoever.

## Raising Awareness about Court Rules

To mitigate noise, we encourage active community compliance with our pickleball hours, and also with paying our Court fees. Please spread the word about the importance of respecting our rules.

We ask that all landlords remind renters about our tennis & pickleball hours and the need to have a Courts membership to play. Please also consider including a note about pickleball hours in any email communications with guests. We appreciate everyone's cooperation.

## Kids Tennis Opportunities

### Tennis Lessons

The changes to the DIIA Kids Tennis Program in 2025 proved to be a success! We will continue with weekday lessons in supporting the next generation of Island players. Lessons for ages 4-13+, will be held every weekday, Monday through Friday, from June 29th to August 14th. We encourage daily attendance. Sneakers and tennis racket are required at every lesson.

#### *Beginner lessons:*

- Time: 11:45am to 12:30pm
- Ages: 4-7
- Children who attend Little Kids Camp will be escorted directly from camp. Please pack a snack for your child to have after camp and before tennis.

#### *Intermediate lessons:*

- Time: 12:30pm to 1:45pm
- Ages: 8+

#### *Cost per Player:*

- \$25 per week; \$100 for 4 weeks; \$200 for the summer
- Note: there is no daily rate; minimum cost is \$25 per week
- Please pay via cash or check on Monday (or your first day of lessons), made out to the "DIIA". Please bring your payment to your Tennis Instructor at your first lesson.

## General Rules

- Courts are to be used only for tennis, pickleball or other pre-approved activities for paid DIIA Plus Courts Members only.
- Tennis shoes (non-marking soles) are required.
- Players are expected to leave the courts neat and tidy. Please mind your trash & pick up litter!
- Any paid DIIA Plus Courts Member may use an unclaimed or open court, with preference to adults on the weekends.
- All players are asked to observe appropriate court etiquette, and to respect the rights of other players. Parents are responsible for their children adhering to the court rules.
- Please direct any questions or concerns to a member of the Courts Committee.

## Reserved Court Time

- DIIA Plus Courts Membership dues and the individual tennis assessments are required to be paid in advance prior to reserving court time.

## Sign-Up Procedures

- A sign-up sheet for the following day's play will be posted by 9am on the bulletin board.
- Sign-up sheets will be posted for fall and spring weekends as needed.
- DIIA organized events and tennis lessons are given priority over all other court use.
- Reserved court time is restricted to 1 hour per individual membership/per day.
- Tournament and Round Robin players may not reserve a court on the day of their event.

## Weekend & Holiday Play

- Children under 16 may play with adults at any time, but may not sign up for adults, or themselves, on weekends or holidays.
- Reserved court time is restricted to 2 hours per family per day on weekends and holidays.

## Cancellations

- Reservations must be canceled at least 30 minutes prior to reservation time.
- A court is forfeited if not claimed within 10 minutes of start time.
- Repeated "No Shows" may result in the loss of court privileges.

# DIIA Memberships

Welcome to the 2026 DIIA summer season! We hope you are ready for a season of fun, friends, and sand between your toes!!

To have a DIIA membership, you must be a DI homeowner, renter of a DI property, or visiting a homeowner or renter.

**There are 3 types of DIIA memberships:**

1. DIIA Membership
2. DIIA Plus Courts Membership
3. DIIA Supporting Membership



A **DIIA membership** allows the member(s) to participate in DIIA activities including day camp. It DOES NOT include the use of any courts or participation in any courts related activities. For homeowners, it is a voting membership.

A **DIIA membership PLUS COURTS** allows the member(s) to participate in DIIA activities including day camp and IS REQUIRED for the use of any courts and/or participation in any courts activities including: free play of tennis and/or pickleball, organized tennis and/or pickleball activities, and tennis lessons. For homeowners, it is a voting membership.

A **DIIA supporting membership** is for those who wish to support the activities of the DIIA but do not intend to participate in any programs or events. You can choose the level of support you wish to give from \$25-\$500. For homeowners, it is a voting membership.

Each membership is intended for ONE family or ONE individual in a household. Additional individuals or families should purchase their own membership(s). Adult children of homeowners or renters are encouraged to purchase their own memberships.

# Day Camp

## Little Kids Day Camp

The fees for Little Kids Day Camp are separate from DIAA Membership dues. Little Kids Day Camp is for children ages 4-7. The day camp meets at the Community House Monday-Friday from 9am to 11:30am. Little Kids Day Camp now accepts cash, checks made out to DIAA, or credit cards via Square.

*All campers must have a completed liability waiver to attend.*

*Available at camp or online.*

Note: the fees listed for 2nd and 3rd child only apply to children of the same immediate family.

## Big Kids Day Camp

Big Kids Day Camp is for children ages 8-13. The day camp meets outdoors at the Community House Monday-Friday from 9am to 11:30am, weather permitting. There is no additional cost for Big Kids Camp. However, DIAA membership dues must be paid for your child to attend.

*All campers must have a completed liability waiver to attend.*

*Available at camp or online.*



# Community House Rules

We ask that you adhere to the following rules:

- The key and permission to use the Community House may be obtained only from the Executive Director, President or Vice President.
- No alcoholic beverages are permitted on DIIA property.
- Music and noise level must be kept down and be respectful of other residents.
- Please NO climbing on the Community House roof or fences.
- There are two (2) playgrounds: the playground located behind the community house is designed and reserved for small children (up to 7 years old). All children older than 7 years old, please use the other playground on the opposite side of the tennis courts. Please remember to respect the rules and the equipment.
- Please respect the Memorial Flag Pole.

We hope that these rules will help maintain good conduct, encourage respect for our neighbors, and preserve our property. Parents, please inform your children of these rules.

## Town of Wells Ordinances

- A permit is required for any outdoor fire - permits can be obtained from the Town of Wells Fire Department.
- No alcohol is allowed on the beach or on any public property.
- The use of consumer fireworks is prohibited anywhere within the Town of Wells - see below for more details.
- Dogs must be leashed - see below for more details.
- The maximum speed limit of Drakes Island is 25 mph or less and modified depending on conditions. Please respect walkers, runners, children play areas, and need to keep down dust on dirt roads.

**Dogs in the Beach Area (§ 86-1)** Between April 1 through June 15, dogs are not permitted within the beach area unless on a leash and under charge of a responsible person. From June 16 through September 15, dogs are not permitted within the beach areas between the hours of 8:00 AM and 6:00 PM. From 6:00 PM until 8:00 AM, dogs are permitted within the beach area only when on a leash and under charge of a responsible person. Exceptions: This section does not apply to dogs on the property of their owner or another property with the owner's permission, to Seeing Eye dogs assisting an individual with a disability, or to working police dogs.

**Clean Up of Pet Waste (§ 80-5)** It is a violation for any person who owns, possesses or controls a dog or any other animal to fail to remove and dispose of any feces left by his/her animal, except on the property belonging to the animal's owner or keeper. Disposal shall be accomplished by transporting such feces to an appropriate waste receptacle.

**Use of Fireworks (§ 115-4)** The use of consumer fireworks is prohibited anywhere within the Town of Wells. Use of consumer fireworks in violation of this chapter shall be subject to a fine plus attorney's fees and costs for each offense.
